

DIY Pumpkin Patch Sensory Bin!

This activity can be used to develop fine motor skills and counting through picking up each pumpkin and matching it to the corresponding numbers! You can also use this sensory bin to teach your kiddo more about Fall!

Pumpkin Patch Materials:

- Bin
- Base (Ex: Dyed rice!)
- Pumpkins
- Optional: Tweezers of some kind

Instructions:

Grab a bin of some kind and add in your grass or dirt! You can use food coloring to dye rice, as an example!

1. Print our *Pumpkin Patch Matching Page* and color it in however you would like!
2. Cut out the pumpkins and plant them in your garden!
3. Use your fingers, tweezers, or something similar to match the pumpkins to their number! Using tweezers or clothespins works on fine motor skills!
4. Have fun picking pumpkins!

Please remember that adult supervision is necessary for a safe and enjoyable experience.
