Instructions:

1. With materials of your choice, create a sensory bin! We used rice dyed green for grass!
2. Now, print the letter matching sheet or create your own for the letters you have!
3. If you don't have letters, print an extra copy of our matching sheet and cut out letters from there!
4. Mix the letters into the sensory bin.
5. Dig and explore! When your kiddo finds a letter, have them match it to the same letter on the page!
